**The aims:** to provide a group study opportunity, divided into three manageable workshops, to explore, develop and build upon the practical tools used within TLSW practice.



This course is for: TLSW practitioners and students who want to think about creating, developing and applying additional tools to use within their practice.

The objectives: to think about tools that meet the individual needs of your young person, to create tailor-made tools and learn practical ways of sharing concepts within TLSW, through play.

**The outcome**: to have a better appreciation for providing bespoke practice, to have developed understanding of themes within TLSW, and to translate these into appropriate, practical tools to enhance your work.

All workshops look at scenarios to encourage creativity, play and differentiation in practice, and increase confidence in meeting the individual needs of the young person.

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




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
